Chairman's Message

hile fishing at Corbet Lough started out well and continued to fish well up to August the season again was impacted by re-occurring climatic events affecting for angling and as a result, boating was unfortunately withdrawn for the month of October. The Committee have agreed to an increase in spend for fish stock for the 2025 season raising our purchase for Rainbow Trout to £21,000, plus £1,000 for Brown Trout with stocking periods similar to the 2024 season and the option to hold back on stocking if the conditions are not favourable. This may also result in some changes to rules on the Corbet Lough. We are hoping to set up a trail for the reduction of Argulus in the lake. As per the attached link.

With reference to the ongoing issues in the Corbet Lough, many of these are manmade and will need a manmade solution to resolve. As we have indicated in previous notes, a trail using Aluminum Sulphate has been carried out in conjunction with the ABC council on other waters. We now need our Councillors and MLA's to push for the approval to use of this product. See the attached link.

I would again like to thank everyone who puts themselves forward in the operational needs of the Angling club and helping to deal with the various issues in its day-to-day operation. Currently we appear to have a reduced Committee size from what we would normally operate with further compounded by the fact that it is very much an aging Committee with the exception of one or two individuals. I would like to invite more support from our members to come forward and help in some way in the support of the Club at Committee level, with a special invitation to the Youth within our membership which is very much needed to secure the future of our Club.

On behalf of the Club, I would like to thank our Riparian owners and farmers for their continued support allowing access along the river Bann and Corbet Lough so that we can enjoy our sport.

As in last year's report I had touched on the work carried out by The Ulster Angling Federation. They continue to press in every direction in the support of angling, and we thank them for their work in this respect. The Federation have recently highlighted that the N. I. Public Angling Estates (DAERA-controlled waters) will again not be stocked in 2025. With DAERA in control of the Public Angling Estate and receiving over £500,000 from Rod Licences and Angling Permits in the 2024 season we are reading from the Federations bulletins that little or no of money from Licences and Permits being reinvested back into Angling.

The collection of fees will be as detailed within this News Sheet. Postal renewals will also be accepted.

The committee would like to offer our sincere condolences to families and friends of those deceased members who are no longer with us. With our membership spread all over the country we are sometimes not aware of their passing and in sending this news sheet out we hope not to cause any offence.
